Angharad received a First Class Honours degree in theatre at Dartington in the UK. In 1994 she became Director of the Performance Space in Sydney. In 1998 she (as Executive Producer) and Gideon Obarzanek established Chunky Move in Melbourne. Angharad joined Peter Sellars as Associate Director in the 2002 Adelaide Festival, and established an international independent production house, risingtideproductions in 2004. She was appointed Director of LIFT (London International Festival of Theatre) 2005 – 2008 and completed a post grad diploma in cultural leadership at City University, London.

She returned to Melbourne directing and curating the first Australian Theatre Forum in 2009, acting General Manager for Lucy Guerin Inc and producing the Marketing Summit 2010 for the Australia Council. She has been on a number of Boards and Panels: Australia Council Hybrid, New Media and Dance Boards, Lucy Guerin Inc, Real Time, Snuff Puppets and Total Theatre (UK).

Angharad is Director of TippingPoint Australia (www.tippingpointaustralia.com) and The Climate Commissions (www.homeartproject.com) energizing the cultural response to climate change. She is also Creative Producer at Arts House, a contemporary performance centre in Melbourne (www.artshouse.com.au) City of Melbourne contemporary arts initiative.
