She was the coordinator (1997 -2000) and then director (2000 -2002) of the Arts & Culture Programme of the Mongolian Foundation for Open Society (Soros Foundation). Ts. Ariunaa was cultural link steering committee member of OSI (Soros Foundation) Arts Culture Network program (1999-2002) to foster cultural mobility among Eastern Europe and Central Asia. In 1996 she was completed Eisenhower Fellowship program to empower global young leaders with funding of US State department. Since 2002 she is the Executive Director of the Arts Council of Mongolia. She was founding member of board of the Open Society Forum (2003-2006) and board member of Mongolian Education Alliance.
