## Becky Llewellyn

Becky Llewellyn has been active in disability and arts in Adelaide South Australia for almost 40 years. Initially, she worked with her disability pioneer husband Richard running Llewellyn Galleries, promoting contemporary Adelaide visual artists.

Becky is a nationally recognised composer of contemporary classical music, including her chamber opera, *The Portrait*, about Adelaide born WWII artist, Stella Bowen. In the past decade she has turned her energies into her role as an access consultant, working to make Adelaide one of Australia's most accessible cities. She serves as Trustee of the Richard Llewellyn Arts and Disability Trust, a dedicated fund set up by the State Government to promote excellence across all art forms by disabled artists and companies. The Trust serves as a model of inclusion and disability-led governance, promoting opportunities for many artists previously marginalised. The innovative program funding and structure has produced a confidence and growing body of arts work by a vibrant field of South Australians who identify as being disabled artists.
