Paul James

Paul James is Director of the Global Cities Institute (RMIT) and Director of the United Nations Global Compact, Cities Programme. He is Professor of Globalization in the Globalism Research Centre (RMIT), on the Council of the Institute of Postcolonial Studies, and a Fellow of the Royal Society of the Arts. He is an editor of *Arena Journal*, as well as an editor/board-member of nine other international journals, including *Globalizations* and *Global Governance*. He has delivered invited addresses in over twenty countries and is author or editor of twenty-four books including most importantly, *Nation Formation* (Sage, 1996) and *Globalism, Nationalism, Tribalism* (Sage, 2006). His other recent books include *Global Matrix* (Pluto, 2005, with Tom Nairn) and the first twelve volumes of a projected sixteen-volume series mapping the field of globalization (Sage, 2006–2010). He has been an advisor to a number of agencies and governments including the Helsinki Process, the Canadian Prime Minister's G20 Forum, the National Economic Advisory Council of Malaysia, and the Commission on Reception, Truth and Reconciliation in East Timor. His work for the Papua New Guinea Minister for Community Development became the basis for their Integrated Community Development Policy.
